Statement from OMB Director Shaun Donovan:

Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled "Establishment of the President's Task Force on 21st Century Policing"

This executive order establishes a task force to make recommendations to the President on how to promote effective crime reduction while building public trust. Implementing this executive order is anticipated to have a de minimis impact on costs and no impact on revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of the executive order include identifying the best means to provide an effective partnership between law enforcement and local communities that reduces crime and increases trust. Implementing this executive order is anticipated to have a de minimis impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, and no impact on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-fiscal year period beginning in fiscal year 2015. The agency anticipated to be impacted by this executive order is the Department of Justice.
