Statement from OMB Director Shaun Donovan:

Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled "Relating to the Implementation of the Convention on the International Recovery of Child Support and Other Forms of Family Maintenance"

This executive order will designate the Department of Health and Human Services as the "Central Authority" responsible for the implementation of the Convention and will allow designation of state child support agencies to assist in the implementation of the Convention. Implementing this executive order is anticipated to have a de minimis impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of the executive order include allowing U.S. implementation of the Convention in a manner that is consistent with current U.S. practice. Implementing this executive order is anticipated to have a de minimis on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, and no impact on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-fiscal year period beginning in fiscal year 2017. The agency anticipated to be impacted by this executive order is the Department of Health and Human Services.
